
Background Information

- ▶ January 2014 SB850 passed for 15 colleges to pilot a baccalaureate program in CTE
 - Current sunset date is 2023
 - Letters of support needed for SB 1406
- ▶ 38 out of 113 community colleges submitted an application
- ▶ 15 were selected for the pilot in Fall of 2014
