

## **Presentation Proposals Guidelines**

The Community College Baccalaureate degree is considered by many as one of the most important disruptions in higher education and particularly in community college during the past 50 years.

The CCBA's annual international conference is the place where the most important and strategic discussions about this movement takes place.

Showcase your college's best practices, model programs and lessons learned, etc.

Presentation formats include: forum and round table discussions. This year we are looking for topics for 5-8 roundtable discussions focusing on how you solved challenges faced.

Your proposal topic should be relevant to those who are interested in community college baccalaureates; best practices, innovative programming, solutions to challenges, benchmarking programs, student support, successes, financial aspects of offering baccalaureate degrees, faculty concerns, and all other issues pertaining to offering four year degrees.

Proposals may also address other innovative ways to improve access to baccalaureate degrees for community college graduates, or could overview the results of a specific program that has improved access including University Center partnerships, 2 + 2, and Distance Learning programs.

Practical issues of implementation and challenges of offering new degree programs are particularly welcomed.

All proposals will be considered. Proposal Deadline: November 30, 2018.

The following information is required for all proposals: Cover Page to Include (1) the presentation title, (2) presenter(s) name(s), (3) institution(s), (4) address(es), (5) telephone number and (6) **email addresses for each presenter.**

Proposal Abstract should include the title and a maximum 100-word description of the presentation.

Biographical Information, will include:

1. Very brief biography (less than 100 words) in sentences (not resume)

2. Digital photograph for each presenter. Please send the photo as an attachment. Photos imbedded in emails are not usable. This will be used in the Conference Program Book.

Presentation Requirements LCD projectors will be available in each room. Please bring your own laptop computer.
